# **Undercoat**

## Coverage

# **Drying time**

Touch dry in 4-6 hours. Recoatable after 16-24 hours.

# Transportation and storage

To avoid the risk of spillage, always store and transport in a secure upright position.

Store away from heat and flame.

# **Preparation**

Ensure surface to be painted is sound, clean, dry and free from grease. Remove all loose and defective paint. Prime all new and bare surfaces with the appropriate Leyland Primer. Rub down sound previously painted surfaces with fine waterproof

abrasive paper to provide a key. Avoid the inhalation of dust. Wear a suitable face mask if dry sanding. Special precautions should be taken during surface preparation of pre-1960s paint surfaces over wood and metal as they may contain harmful lead. For further advice contact Technical Advisory.

# **Application**

Stir well before use. Suitable for application by brush or roller. The brush should be fully loaded for best results. Do not thin. Apply one or more coats as required and allow 16-24 hours drying between coats under normal conditions. Do not apply over polystyrene surfaces.

## Cleaning

Remove as much product as possible from application equipment before cleaning. Clean equipment immediately after use with White Spirit or Turpentine Substitute. Some local authorities have special facilities for disposal of waste coatings. Do not empty product into drains or watercourses. Replace lid firmly.

- Not recommended for interior use on large surface areas, or in confined spaces.
- Store in a well-ventilated place. Keep cool.
- Keep container tightly closed.
